## Background

In order to sit for the BACB®'s RBT exam, at the time of application you'll need to:



Be 18 years of age or older

&



Have a high school diploma or equivalent

&



Be able to pass a criminal background check

## Training

To become an RBT, you will need to complete a 40-hour training program that covers many topics, including:

ETHICS

BEHAVIOR REDUCTION



### Behavior Analysis Essentials

This course has been updated to meet the RBT Task List® 2.0 including Ethics 2.0

This training program is based on the Registered Behavior Technician Task List (2nd ed.) and is designed to meet the 40-hour training requirement for the RBT credential. The program is offered independent of the BACB.

## Assessment

These assessments are not offered by ABA Technologies or Florida Tech ABA Online Program.

### COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT

Direct observation conducted by a BACB certificant to assess the performance of skills as outlined in the RBT Task List provided by the BACB.



### KNOWLEDGE EXAMINATION

A computerized exam taken at a testing center, consisting of 75 multiple choice questions to be completed in 90 minutes. This exam is also based on the RBT Task List.

## In Summary

- 1 ✓ Make sure you meet the background requirements: over 18 years old, high school grad or equivalent, and can pass a criminal background check
- 2 ✓ Complete your 40-hour training course (Such as Behavior Analysis Essentials)
- 3 ✓ Complete your competency assessment no more than 90 days prior to applying for the credential.
- 4 ✓ Complete your criminal background check within 180 days of applying for the credential.
- 5 ✓ Complete your application and sit for the RBT exam.
- 6 ✓ Get your exam results, and start making a positive difference in people's lives!
